- **Parking**
 - additional parking is needed
 - use newly purchased property to install additional parking (approx. 32 spaces)
 - is there a way to connect upper and lower parking on west side of park by using the private/public road?
 - eliminate parking along Woodhill
 - could fencing or screening be installed along field one and field three to prevent foul balls from hitting parked cars (ex: Hopkins ball field)
- **Trail**
 - slope is much too steep for elderly people and not H.C. accessible
 - look into incorporating a longer loop that is accessible for all
 - used by skateboarders (very dangerous)
- **Lookout pavilion**
 - this could be east of the concession building
 - would like to see picnic table and benches with an overhead shade structure or canopy
 - this area could also be used for events not related to baseball or softball activities
- **Permanent charcoal grills**
 - a nice alternative to concessions
 - could be used for events such as family day
- **Picnic tables and benches**
 - strong desire for a place to sit and eat lunch
- **Playground area**
 - need a fence or barrier between Excelsior Boulevard and play area
- **Pedestrian access from Excelsior Boulevard**
 - is there a way to make a safe connection from Excelsior Boulevard to park?
- **Softball Field**
 - area around left dugout often has standing water
 - straighten out fence
- **Baseball field 2 spectator seating**
 - amphitheater style seating
 - build seating and trail loop into side of steep hill
 - move dugouts further down line (can't see 3rd base from concession overlook)
- **Baseball field 3**
 - entrance onto field is poorly located
 - orientation is directly into sun
 - create spectator seating that is comfortable by providing shade and good views
- **Dugouts**
 - fencing is too short in height
 - overall size could be enlarged
- **Maintain access to well-pump located in the northwest corner of the lower level fields**
- **Berm south of softball field**
 - water runoff results in standing water in sidewalk and erosion of berm
 - highly trafficked by pedestrians
- **Pitching/Batting cages**
 - provide a designated space for these activities
- **Relocate Flagpoles**
- **Landscape Improvements**
 - Protect mature trees during construction
 - Install more overstory trees
- **Pump house building**
 - children have started to use this as a bounce wall
- **Maintain sand pit west of field 2 for children**
- **Storage Facility**
 - in master plan designate where this could be installed in the future
- **Southeast area of park**
 - look into whether or not this area can be built upon or what its purpose is
- **Install no dog signs for all ball fields**
