What is being proposed?

A master plan concept will be reviewed based off of input received from the Parks, Open Space and Trails System Plan, a neighborhood survey, multiple neighborhood meetings and Park Board meetings. Concepts for both parks are available for viewing at www.eminnetonkaparksrenewal.com.

What happens at the meeting?

The meeting will consist of a brief review of the input received, discussion on the prior concepts and review of the proposed master plan. The City Council will open the meeting to hear your input and/or to ask questions of the master plan.

Will there be future meetings?

If the project is approved, the only remaining meeting to be conducted will be a future meeting to consider bids for each project.

Will I be assessed?

There are no assessments being proposed for this project. Funding is allotted as a result of the 2001 Parks and Open Space Referendum.
