

Jidana Park
Neighborhood Meeting #2 Summary
March 10, 2004

The concept for Jidana Park was reviewed by residents. The plan calls for:

- Re-grading the entrance road;
- Removing all but 2 campsites, & adding permanent seating to one;
- Re-grade the parking lot.

The following additions were suggested:

- Smooth out side banks on the crest of the hill where the road from the entrance ends.
- Entrance gate: Make it more welcoming, possibly change style.
- Remove signs pertaining to archery, as well as the hay bales when not being used for Camp Jidana.
- Dock: Check for safety and stability.
- Check with Park Maintenance on frequency of mowing.
- Tree Trust: Can they help repair steps, dock, Natural Resource Management on the island?

The master plan will be reviewed at the Park Board Meeting, held April 21 at 7:00pm in the City Council Chambers. Residents are welcome to attend and speak their opinions!
