What is being proposed?

A master plan concept will be reviewed based off of input received from the Parks, Open Space and Trails System Plan, a neighborhood survey and two neighborhood meetings.

What happens at the meeting?

The meeting will consist of a brief review of the input received, discussion on the prior concepts and review of the proposed master plan. The Park Board will open the meeting to hear your input and/or to ask questions of the master plan.

Will there be future meetings?

Yes. Assuming the Park Board adopts the master plan, the City Council will review their recommendation at their meeting on July 28, 2003. You are encouraged to attend all of these public meetings. If the Park Board does not adopt the master plan, they will conduct additional meetings on McKenzie Park at their next regular meeting.

Will I be assessed?

There are no assessments being proposed for this project. Funding is allotted as a result of the 2001 Parks and Open Space Referendum.
