**Background**

In accordance with City Council authorization, a city Primary Election was held on September 13, 2005. The offices on the ballots were Council at Large, Seat A, and Council at Large, Seat B. The purpose of the Primary was to determine which two candidates for each of these positions will progress to the General Election ballot. The General Election will be held on November 8, 2005, and the office of Mayor will be on that ballot in addition to the two at large positions.

Based on the tabulation of the votes, the results are included in the resolution.

**RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE SEPTEMBER 13, 2005

Section 1. Background.
