# YOUNG REMBRANDTS, A Children's Drawing Program, DEBUT IS SUCCESSFUL...

Hennepin County could someday be the home of an artist who first learned his or her craft at one of the YOUNG REMBRANDTS drawing classes being held in Edina, Hopkins, Eden Prairie or Minnetonka.

Children ages 3 1/2 - 13 are trying their hand at learning basic drawing skills through artistic techniques ranging from staying within the lines, creating funny faces with cartooning or pastel work at the enrichment classes now in session.

Judi Mullin of Minnetonka has opened the first Young Rembrandts drawing program in Hennepin County and has had an overwhelming response by local families and schools. The program is a national franchise, new to the area, that provides children with a chance to learn to draw and add color to their work. The Young Rembrandts corporate offices are in the Chicago, Illinois area and grew out of an idea from Bette Fetter who realized there was a lack of programs in which children learn actual drawing skills. 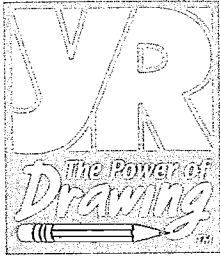
